In Windows Movie Maker, it is not possible to add music and narration at a time in a video however as a work around, you may try this:

Step 1

- 1) Open a new Movie Maker Project.
- 2) Add your Videos to the timeline/storyboard.
- 3) Add the audio recordings (narration clips) in the timeline.
- 4) Make adjustments to video and sound track.
- 5) Export the Video file.

Step 2

- 1) Then open up a new a Movie maker project.
- 2) Import the Exported Video file.
- 3) Add the music to the timeline.
- 4) Adjust the volume control on the left side of the timeline to the pan the sound to audio or music.
- 5) Export the video.
