Grade 10 BBT Final Project

This project is your final summative evaluation and is valued at 30% of your final mark. It is due no later than the last day of classes. Extensions will not be allowed. To complete the final project you must create a web site consisting of work done in the course. Essentially, this will be a portfolio of your work and capabilities in the class. You are encouraged to add personal touches to the site above and beyond what we have done in your modules.

You will have two weeks to complete this project within class time. If you miss class time due to illness, you will be allowed to work on the project during lunch hour.

Your website must include the following:

- 1. A separate folder in your student drive titled **BBT 10 Final Project**, which will hold <u>all</u> your project files.
- 2. A word document titled **Web Page Design Storyboard** which shows your page design template for your web pages. This template is to show your links, paragraphs, and pictures. Remember to keep your links consistent throughout your site.
- 3. A home page saved as **index.html** which includes a link to each of the pages in your web site and information about BBT Class (what does BBT stand for).
- 4. A page for <u>each</u> of the modules you have completed during the term. Pages must include:
 - \checkmark The name of the module,
 - ✓ A brief description of the module,
 - ✓ A description of the activities/projects you completed
 - ✓ They must also include a picture and a screen shot of one of your activities
 - ✓ These pages are all to be named the same as the module. For example: Sketch-Up.html
- 5. An 'About Me' page about you, your hobbies, interests and other information you would like to share. This can be a revised submission of your Dreamweaver "My Site" Project.
- 6. Links all pages must have a <u>consistent</u> navigation menu to your index page and all other pages.
- 7. Images all pages must have at least one graphic/image/.GIF or WMP.
- 8. References For internet images used, you must include a <u>reference page</u> where you list all your outside sources for information, pictures, and sound. It must be listed and all sources must be linked to the source web page.
